Entry Deadline: February 19, 2010

Weigh In: 5:00 - 7:00 PM, Friday, March 5, 2010

Show: Steers - 1:00 PM, Saturday, March 6,

Heifers - 11:00AM, Sunday, March 7

Showmanship: Immediately following the Heifer Show on Sunday March 7.

1. Market steers must have been the property of the exhibitor on or before December 1, 2008. Feeder steers, steer calves and heifers must have been owned for at least 30 days prior to the show. Proof of ownership required at check-in.

2. Steers will be divided into three weight categories - Steer calves up to 650 lbs, Feeder Steers 651 - 999 lbs, and Market Steers 1000 lbs & up.

Heifers will be shown by breeds. Those breeds having less than 10 head may be combined into an All Other Breeds category. Crossbred heifers must have a known birth date.

3. Showmanship will be broken into two age categories - Juniors being those that are 13 and under as of January 1, 2010, and Seniors being those that are 14 and older as of January 1, 2010.

Juniors must be eight(8) years old as of March 1, 2010 and seniors must not have reached their twenty first(21) birthday as of March 1, 2010. Please bring Birth Certificate to Check In.

1. All swine must be the property of the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to the show. Proof of ownership required at check-in.

2. Market/feeder pigs will be divided into two weight categories. Feeder pigs are those weighing less than 200 pounds, market pigs are those weighing 200 pounds and up. Gilts must weigh at least 75 lbs and must not have farrowed and will show by breeds. Those breeds having less than 10 head may be combined into an All Other Breeds category. Commercial gilts must have a known birth date. Gilts shown in the market/feeder classes are not eligible to show in the breeding classes.

3. Ear notches and premise ID must match hauling papers or the pig will not be eligible to show.

4. Showmanship will be broken into two age categories - Juniors being those that are 13 and under as of January 1, 2010, and Seniors being those that are 14 and older as of January 1, 2010. Juniors must be eight(8) years old by March 1, 2010 and Seniors must not have reached their 21st birthday by March 1, 2010. Please bring Birth Certificate to check in.

Showmanship: Following the Breeding and Market Shows

1. All goats must be the property of the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to the show. Proof of ownership required at check-in.
2. Market goats open to wethers and does with milk teeth. Market Goats must have been dehorned and sheared with no more than 3/8" of hair growth except below the knees, hocks and tail switch. Minimum weight for feeder goats is 35 pounds and maximum weight is 69 pounds. Market goat weights are 70 pounds and up.
3. Breeding goats must be fullblood or percentage Boers and are not required to be dehorned. Percentage goats must have a known birthdate.
4. Showmanship will be broken into two age categories - Juniors being those that are 13 and under as of January 1, 2010, and Seniors being those that are 14 and older as of January 1, 2010. Juniors must be eight(8) years old by March 1, 2010 and Seniors must not have reached their 21st birthday by March 1, 2010. Please bring Birth Certificate to Check In.

Showmanship: Following the Breeding Sheep, Saturday, March 6, 2010

1. All sheep must have been the property of the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to the show. Proof of ownership required at check-in.
2. Lambs will be divided into two weight categories with a minimum weight limit of 50 pounds. Feeder lamb weights will be 50 - 99 pounds, market lambs are 100 pounds and up. Breeding sheep will show by breeds. Those breeds having less than 10 head may be combined into an All Other Breeds category. Commercial sheep must have known birth dates.
3. Showmanship will be broken into two age categories - Juniors being those that are 13 and under as of January 1, 2010, and Seniors being those that are 14 and older as of January 1, 2010. Juniors must be eight(8) years old by March 1, 2010 and Seniors must not have reached their 21st birthday by March 1, 2010. Please bring Birth Certificate to check in.

Contest Criteria

Contest will consist of a total of six classes of cattle, sheep and swine. Two classes may also include performance data. One class will have oral reasons. Eight minutes will be allowed for each class. Contestants will be scored on their placings and oral reasons.

Rules

1. Entry forms are due with other entries on February 19, 2010. Post entries will be accepted at double the entry fee. Entry forms must be signed by the coach of the team to be processed.
2. Contestants in the youth division must not have reached their 21st birthday by January 1, 2010. Youth teams may be comprised of 4H or FFA members or anyone complying with the age requirements. youth teams will have four members, the top three scores will be counted. Individuals may compete for individual placings.
3. Alternates(a fifth member) may be listed on the entry form. Alternates may substitute for any missing member of the team. If no members are missing the alternates may participate as individuals after paying the appropriate fee. No late fee will be assessed.
4. Only contestants and contest officials are permitted in the Livestock Judging area.
5. Questions must be directed to contest officials only. Contestants may not confer with anyone during the contest.
6. Rule violations will cause elimination from the contest and forfeiture of all awards.

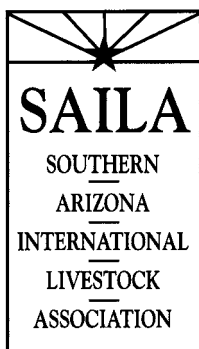

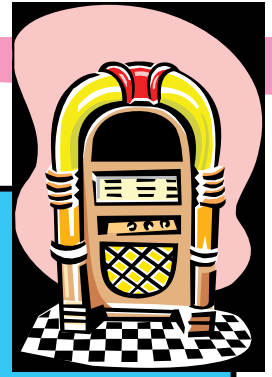

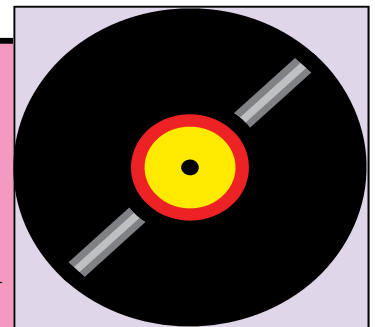
